The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (in short, “Cr.P.C”) for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0227 dated 18.9.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 399, 402 of Indian Penal Code (for short, “IPC”) (Section 411 IPC added later on) at Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Heard.

FIR was registered on the allegations that on 18.9.2018, the investigating officer received secret information that Navdeep Singh alias Navi petitioner along with his associates had stolen one chest from the liquor vendor few days back and also snatched cash amount from the *Munim* of the liquor vendor and at that time, they were armed with deadly weapons and making preparations to commit dacoity. A raid was conducted

and one motor cycle was recovered from the petitioner.

Learned State counsel states that challan has been submitted.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Navdeep Singh alias Navi son of Sukhpal Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
