This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.141 dated 2.3.2015 under sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 506, 34 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, City Jind, District Jind.

Perusal of the FIR reveals that the dispute has emanated out of non-performance of contractual obligations arising out of an agreement to sell.

During the course of arguments today counsel for the petitioner as also the complainant/respondent no.2 are *ad idem* that a settlement has been arrived at between the parties. This Court has further been informed that a quashing petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C i.e. CRM-M-8083-2018 has been filed in this Court seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise and in which notice of motion has already been issued.

Even learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Vinod

Kumar informs that the petitioners in pursuance to the order dated 7.2.2018

have joined investigation.

In view of the above, custodial interrogation of the petitioners, as such, would not be warranted. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 7.2.2018, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
