RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

1. Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing FIR No. 12 dated 24.02.2016 under Sections 259, 341, 506 of the IPC at Police Station Sadar Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 07.12.2017 (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

2. Vide orders dated 21.12.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded for compromise with a direction to the trial Court, to furnish a report qua veracity of the compromise.

3. Consequently, parties appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Batala and got recorded their statements qua compromise on 12.01.2018. Report from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Batala, vide

letter No.80 dated 29.01.2018, duly endorsed to learned District and Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, vide Endst. No. 1666/RKT, Dated, 30.01.2018, has been received. According to the report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Batala, the compromise is valid and genuine and it is voluntarily effected between the parties with their free consent and without any pressure, threat, coercion or undue influence, pressure and coercion from any quarter.

4. In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, this petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR No. 12 dated 24.02.2016 under Sections 259, 341, 506 of the IPC at Police Station Sadar Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioner is quashed, subject to payment of costs of Rs. 10,000/-, out of which Rs. 4,000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association of Punjab and Haryana, High Court, Rs. 1000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and Rs. 5,000/- with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Legal Services Committee, within two weeks from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.
