The petitioner seeks concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.258 dated 8.6.2018, registered at Police Station Manimajra, Chandigarh, under Sections 406, 420 IPC.

The allegations in the FIR are that the petitioner and her co-accused took money from the complainant for getting him employed as a Driver in the Punjab and Haryana High Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that to show her bona fide, the petitioner is willing to deposit a sum of Rs.1 lac. The petitioner is an illiterate lady and she took a loan with the assistance of the main accused and thus, she has been falsely implicated.

The submission appears to be extremely far-fetched. If the petitioner did take a loan with the assistance of the main accused, the same is no reason for getting her implicated in the present case. If the petitioner is innocent, then she should not be making an offer at the outset to deposit a sum of Rs.1 lac, which has allegedly been traced to her account. The arguments are not convincing at all.

For the reasons hereinabove, the petition has no merit and is dismissed.
