The petitioner is an accused in FIR No.26 dated 6.4.2017, registered at Police Station Banur, District Mohali, under Sections 452, 307, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959. He was arrested and granted regular bail. However, vide order dated 26.9.2018 (Annexure P2) his bail bonds have been cancelled as he failed to appear and non-bailable warrant of arrest has been issued against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had been arrested in another FIR on 22.9.2018 and thus, he could not appear before the trial Court on 26.9.2018. Exemption application was also filed, but the same was erroneously rejected by the trial Court.

In view of the facts and circumstances of this case, the petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before 21.11.2018 and move an application for regular bail. On his doing so, the trial Court shall grant him regular bail subject to its satisfaction.
