**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.43 dated 05.06.2015 under Sections 326/323/324/325/506/34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Batala, District Gurdaspur, on the basis of compromise dated 13.12.2017 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is an outcome of a property dispute between the brothers, which has now been resolved. The matter has been compromised.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 21.12.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Batala,

has sent his report dated 10.05.2018, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a property dispute between the brothers, which has now been resolved.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" **2014 (6) SCC 466**, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.43 dated 05.06.2015 under Sections 326/323/324/325/506/34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
