Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail pending trial to the petitioner in case FIR No.144 dated 06.10.2018 registered under Sections 384, 34 IPC at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 07.10.2018 and the trial in the case will take long time as challan has not been presented yet.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid facts.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 07.10.2018 and the trial in the case will take sufficient long time as challan has not been presented yet, this Court finds that the petitioner deserves to be

admitted on bail.

Accordingly, present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail subject to her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

It is made clear that the petitioner will not extend any threat or undue influence on the witnesses in any manner.
