This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.285 dated 25.06.2012, under Sections 406/409/419/420/467/468/471/473/120-B IPC and Section 13 (1) (d) read with Section 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Civil lines, Amritsar.

Pleadings on record would indicate that vide common order dated 19.03.2013 passed by this Court in a bunch of petitions preferred by the present petitioner as also other co-accused, the benefit of regular bail had been granted (Annexure P-2). Thereafter, petitioner having absented from trial proceedings, the concession of bail was cancelled and bail bonds/surety bonds were forfeited to the State.

The instant petition came up for preliminary hearing

before this Court on 21.12.2017 and while issuing notice of motion, petitioner was directed to surrender before the trial Court and in the eventuality of his doing so, he was to be released on interim bail subject to its satisfaction.

During the course of hearing today, petitioner has furnished a certified copy of order dated 10.01.2018 and a perusal thereof would reveal that the petitioner has duly surrendered before the trial Court and has been admitted to interim bail on having furnished personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- and with one surety of the like amount.

Order dated 10.01.2018 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

Petitioner having joined trial proceedings, prayer made in the instant petition is accepted.

Order dated 21.12.2017, passed by this Court is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
