1. On 15.01.2018, following order was passed by this
Court:-

"CRM-1106-2018

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the application is allowed and the sale deed dated 17.09.2015 is taken on record subject to just exception.

CRM-M-49231-2017

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the land measuring 248 square yards belonging to the complainant-Santosh was transferred in the name of Sunita vide registered sale deed dated 19.11.2014. The petitioner is the subsequent purchaser from

Sunita. The sale deed dated 19.11.2014 has not been challenged by the complainant so far.

Adjourned to 09.03.2018.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 20.01.2018 at 11.00 A.M. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that pursuant to order dated 15.01.2018, petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Dharambir Singh admitted the aforesaid fact and stated that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.
4. In view of above, order dated 15.01.2018 is hereby made absolute.
5. Petition stands disposed of.
