The petitioner alleges that the private respondent has assaulted him, but no FIR is being registered against the said respondent. Instead, a false and frivolous FIR has been registered against the petitioner, to shield the private respondent. A representation dated 30.10.2018 (Annexure P3) has been submitted, but the same has been marked to respondent Nos.3, who is allegedly colluding with respondent No.4.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.S. Bains, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day. In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent No.4, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to get representation dated 30.10.2018 (Annexure P3) enquired into and decided by any other superior police official except respondent No.3 and on the basis of the enquiry, appropriate action be taken, in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
