Present petition is filed praying for quashing FIR No.129 dated 21.12.2016, under Sections 452/323/427/506/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Raikot, District Ludhiana, on the basis of compromise entered into between the parties.

2. Heard.

3. Both the parties were directed by this Court vide order dated 15.2.2017 to appear before the learned Illaqa Magistrate and get their statements recorded and in pursuance thereof, learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jagraon, recorded the statements of both the parties and

submitted a report 2.3.2017. A perusal of the report reveals that the compromise entered into between the parties is voluntary and without any fear, coercion, inducement or threat.

4. Inasmuch as the dispute between the parties has been amicably settled and they have already entered into compromise, continuance of the prosecution would be an exercise in futility. Therefore, the aforesaid FIR and all consequent proceedings resulting therefore are quashed.

5. Petition is allowed.
