This is third bail application filed under Section 439

Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.186 dated 18.10.2015, registered under Sections 302, 307, 326, 324, 323 and 148 read with Section 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Sadar, Patiala.

It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present FIR. The name of the petitioner does not figure in the FIR. No role whatsoever has been assigned to the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that the participation of the petitioner is very much made out and he inflicted injuries on the person of Raghbir Singh.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the petitioner along with his co-accused inflicted several injuries to complainant Lajja Ram and his brother Raghbir Singh and Daljit Singh. In the scuffle, Daljit Singh was done to death. The petitioner is attributed gun shot injury which hit injured Raghbir Singh. Otherwise also, this is third bail application. No fresh circumstance is made out in favour of the petitioner. Consequently, the present petition is dismissed.
