This is second bail application filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail in FIR No.335 dated 31.10.2014 registered under Sections 285, 336 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station City Rewari, District Rewari.

Learned State counsel informs that testimony of all the PWs stands recorded and the case is at the fag end.

The petitioner is involved in as many as 12 FIRs and no fresh circumstance is made out to grant the concession of bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed.

Keeping in view the order dated 26.05.2017, whereby a direction was issued to the learned trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within three months and the subsequent

extension granted vide order dated 18.09.2017, whereby the trial Court was directed to conclude the trial within another four weeks time, it is directed that the trial Court shall take up the matter on day to day basis and ensure that the trial is concluded expeditiously preferably within three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order under intimation to the learned Registrar General of this Court.
