Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No. 2 to enquire into the said representation (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate action in accordance with law, in case commission of any cognizable offence is made out within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
