Through the instant petition filed under Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioners have sought protection of their life and liberty who are under constant threats at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 being politically influential persons with direction to official respondents to arrest respondents No.4 and 5 in case FIR No.106 dated 18.11.2017 registered under Sections 307, 452, 34 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, Tehsil Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Petition is disposed of with direction to official respondents to take appropriate steps to arrest respondents No.4 and 5 if they are found to be named for having committed a cognizable offence and directions given

in Para No.13 in the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court titled as *Arnesh Kumar Vs. State of Bihar and another, 2014(3) RCR (Criminal)* 527. State is directed to act according with the ratio.
