This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.47, dated 16.04.2016, under Section 323/341/382/506/324/148/149/120-B IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Doraha, District Ludhiana.

During the course of arguments today, it has gone uncontroverted that name of the petitioner did not figure in the complainant's version. Petitioner is sought to be implicated on the statement of co-accused, Gurdeep Singh @ Mithu.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Sajjan Singh informs the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation and no recovery is to be effected from him.
