This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of appropriate direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and minor daughters and for providing security to the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 9 herein.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already approached respondent No. 2-Superintendent of Police, Jind, by way of a representation dated 30.01.2018 (Annexure P-2) for redressal of her grievance, however, the said representation is still pending

consideration. He further submits that, at this stage, the petitioner would feel satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the said representation expeditiously.

Upon notice, appearance has been caused on behalf of the official respondents as well as private respondents. Counsel for the respondents-State submits that the matter will be looked into in accordance with law.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties in view thereof, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Superintendent of Police, Jind to decide the representation dated 30.01.2018 in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of.
