GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that consequent upon commission of suicide by her husband, the matrimonial house where she was residing with her daughters has been locked by the police and she along with her daughters are not being allowed to occupy the house on the ground that same is being preserved as evidence of scene of occurrence. Learned counsel has further submitted that proceedings in respect of the FIR regarding suicide by her husband have already been stayed by this Court. It has been submitted that although a representation Annexure P-3 had been submitted to the police authorities by the petitioner, but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-3) expeditiously and in case, the allegations made therein are found to be well-founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously, preferably within a period of '**one month**' from today.
