This is a petition that has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 78 dated 04.09.2017 under Sections 306/34 of the IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka.

This Court was pleased to pass the following order on 12.02.2018 :-

“Counsel for the respondent-State submits that report from the Forensic Science Laboratory has come.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Adjourned to 30.05.2018.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation on 15.02.2018 at 11.00 a.m. and on his doing so, the petitioner be released on interim bail

subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for investigation any further.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State, on instructions from the investigating Officer, confirms the aforesaid fact.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 12.02.2018 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation; will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
