LISA GILL, J.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 194 dated 27.05.2017 under Sections 306, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Basti Jodhewal, District Ludhiana.

Contentions noted on behalf of the petitioner while issuing notice of motion read as under:-

“ It is submitted that there is no allegation against the present petitioner to constitute offences punishable under Sections 306, 506 and 34 IPC. Even as per allegations in the FIR, quarrel had taken place between the complainant and the petitioner on 19.02.2017. Co-accused Pintu made a phone call to the complainant's daughter (deceased) due to which she committed suicide. Relationship between the complainant's daughter and co-accused Pintu are alleged in the FIR.”

It is submitted that the petitioner has since joined investigation pursuant to interim order passed by this Court. The petitioner undertakes to

face the proceedings and not misuse the concession of anticipatory bail, if confirmed. It is, thus, prayed that this petition be allowed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Hardeep Singh, verifies that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required. The petitioner is not reported to be involved in any other criminal case.

There are no allegations on behalf of the State that the petitioner is likely to abscond or that he is likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances noted above but without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, it is considered just and expedient to allow this petition. Consequently, order dated 22.12.2017 is made absolute.
