ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.244 dated 19.12.2016 under Sections 419, 420, 120-B, 201 (Sections 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC were added subsequently), registered at Police Station City Kharar, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali), on the basis of compromise dated 15.12.2017 (Annexure P-2), which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is an outcome of a monetary dispute over sale/purchase of property between mother-in-law and daughter-in-law, which has now been resolved and the matter has now been compromised.

This Court by the order dated 21.12.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the

compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of SDJM, Kharar, dated 05.01.2018 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine and without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a monetary dispute over sale/purchase of property between mother-in-law and daughter-in-law, which has now been resolved and the matter has now been compromised.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466***, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.244 dated 19.12.2016 under Sections 419, 420, 120-B, 201 (Sections 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC were added subsequently), registered at Police Station City Kharar, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioner(s).
