This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail by the petitioner.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that no recovery is to be effected from the petitioner and he is ready to join investigation.

On the other hand learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmail Singh has pointed out that the arrest warrant of the petitioner has been issued for 9.2.2018 and he is evading his arrest in the present case and prolonging the trial.

Perusal of the paper-book reveals that the petitioner is duly named in the FIR and he was the member of the conspiring group for planning to damage railway stations, bus stand, power houses, Government buses, Post Offices and other Governmental and non-government properties by putting them on fire.

Therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is dismissed.
