In view of the application, the same is allowed and amended
memo of parties is taken on record.

Main Case

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he had been
given beatings by respondents No.4 to 8 after having been called to the
school where he was working and regarding which a DDR No.28 was
lodged on 10.10.2018 but no action has been taken thereafter despite the
fact he had also submitted the representation dated 06.11.2018 (Annexure
P-4).

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Moga to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-4) expeditiously and in case, the allegations made therein and in the said DDR are found to be well-founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest.

A copy of this order, DDR No.28 dated 10.10.2018 along with copy of representation (Annexure P-4) be sent to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Moga so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
