At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the application dated 03.11.2018 (Annexure P-3) should be decided expeditiously.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Ms. Rajni Gupta, Senior DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioner within a period of six weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper

book be supplied to her during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the application dated 03.11.2018 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
