Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.77 dated 03.05.2016 under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that it is on account of absence of the petitioner on 12.03.2018, his bail was cancelled and non-bailable warrants have been issued against him. The petitioner is otherwise ready to appear before the trial Court. He further states that there is no other case against the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Tanvir Joshi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that there being a single default on the part of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner appears before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and move an application for grant of regular bail, he shall be admitted on bail on furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.

The petitioner shall also submit an undertaking before the trial Court that in future, he shall not make themselves absented in the trial.
