MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.136 dated 05.07.2018 registered under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

On 17.11.2018, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the version given in the FIR is that deceased Ram Pal has left suicide note levelling allegations against the petitioner and co-accused Ravi and Mandeep Kumar alias Kalu for giving threats to him and harassing his daughter in law but the matter was initially compromised and co-accused Ravi Kumar and Mandeep Kumar alias Kalu have already been granted interim bail by this Court vide orders dated 03.10.2018 and 12.11.2018, passed in CRM- M Nos.38897 and 49285 of 2018 respectively.

Notice of motion for 19.12.2018.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Arresting/Investigating Officer within seven days. On doing so, he shall be released on interim bail,

*subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him.
To be heard alongwith CRM M-38897 of 2018.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 17.11.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Angrej Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 17.11.2018, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
