The petitioner has approached this Court for grant of concession of regular bail in case FIR No.15, dated 03.02.2017, registered under Sections 148, 149, 302, 341 IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 at Police Station Guhla, District Kaithal.

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is neither named in the FIR nor has the complainant named him in his statement before the Trial Court. He contends that although in the supplementary statement the petitioner was so named but since the complainant has omitted to mention the name of the petitioner in his statement on 12.10.2017 (Annexure P-1) while appearing as PW1, he may

be granted the concession of regular bail.

Counsel for the State could not dispute the assertions made by
counsel for the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances of the case,
the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to be released on
bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial
Court/Duty Magistrate, Kaithal.
