Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of order dated 10.1.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The factum of joining the investigation has been affirmed by learned State counsel on instructions from HC Sukhdev Singh. She further submits that two more cases under the Excise Act are there against the petitioner.
