The present petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 153 dated 04.12.2017, registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station Pasiana, District Patiala.

Reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Rajwinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Samana has been filed in the Court today and is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the complainant has filed photocopy of affidavit dated 27.11.2017 filed in Crl. W.P. No. 1324 of 2017 and the same is also taken on record.

According to the affidavit dated 27.11.2017, referred to above Seema Rani was not traceable, thus, patently incorrect statement had been made on 28.12.2017 leading to the passing of interim directions in favour of the petitioners.

The very basis of grant of interim protection was non-existent and therefore, the petitioners are not entitled for grant of anticipatory bail.

The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
