The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of
the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking anticipatory bail on behalf
of the petitioner in case FIR No.222 dated 11th November, 2017

registered under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar Rural.

Seen MLR of the victim as well as the summary dated 11th November, 2017 issued by the Fortis Hospital where the victim was allegedly brought on 10th November, 2017. There is an endorsement to the effect “(Danger to Life)” although nature of the injuries *per se* have not been mentioned. According to the FIR, the petitioner had caught hold of the victim but the actual assaults by sharp edged weapons were committed by his brother namely Gurpreet Singh, who is already arrested and has been detained for almost 1½ months now.

Considering the limited role of the present petitioner namely Gurwinder Singh in the matter of actual assault on the victim, he may be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/ Investigating Officer subject to compliance of requisite formalities under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
