This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of interim bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.16 dated 27.10.2014 under Sections 21, 25 & 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short the - 'NDPS Act') registered at Police Station – SSOC, Amritsar, for a period of 15 days to enable him to attend the marriage of his daughter Manpreet Kaur, which is scheduled to be held on 26.11.2018 for making arrangements as well as to perform certain ceremonies which are required being father of the daughter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the presence of the petitioner is required at the time of marriage of his daughter. The petitioner filed another petition *i.e.* CRM-M No.50303 of 2018 for grant of interim bail in case FIR No.01 dated 12.06.2017 under Sections 59 (2) (b),

21, 22 of the NDPS Act along with some other Sections for the same purpose, which has been allowed vide order dated 21.11.2018.

Learned State counsel has verified the factum of marriage of daughter of the petitioner, which is scheduled on 26.11.2018.

Heard.

By considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner; the factum of marriage has been affirmed by learned State counsel and also the fact that the petitioner has also been granted interim bail in the other case as mentioned above for a period of 15 days from the date of his release, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted interim bail for a period of 15 days from the date of his release subject to furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the jail authorities immediately after expiry of period of 15 days.
