The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.354 dated 27.11.2017 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala (Annexure P1) along with the consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise (Annexure P2).

Report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sultanpur Lodhi, received. Statements of both the parties have been recorded. It is reported that the parties have effected compromised, which is genuine, voluntary, without any threat, pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the matter, FIR No.354 dated 27.11.2017 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala (Annexure P1) along with all the

consequential proceedings stands quashed qua the petitioners.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
