Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her minor children and further for issuance of direction to respondent No.6 not to harass the petitioner, as a consequence of registration of FIR No.77 dated 07.09.2017 under Sections 302/120-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, Police Station Banur, District Patiala.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mohan Singh, submits that husband of the petitioner namely Nirmaljit Singh @ Nimma has already been arrested and the police is searching for his brother namely Sukhjit and Amrit & Simrat sons of Gurnam Singh, who are also accused in the aforesaid FIR. It is further submitted that the petitioner and her minor children are neither accused in the aforesaid FIR No.77 nor are required for the purpose of investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is rendered as infructuous. However, it is clarified that still in case the petitioner is required for any investigation, she may be given advance notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C.

Disposed of, accordingly.
