The petitioners have filed this petition seeking quashing of FIR No.25 dated 18.02.2014 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Matour on the basis of affidavit filed by complainant, namely, Jagdish Chand Bhardwaj which indicates that the parties have entered into a compromise. No copy of compromise is attached with this petition.

Since the offences punishable under Sections 406 and 420 of IPC i.e. the alleged offences are compoundable, therefore, the counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the petition with liberty to move an appropriate application for compounding the offences before the Court below.
