By this common order this Court proposes to dispose of all the
above mentioned three petitions.

The above-mentioned petitions have been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 02 dated 07.01.2017 under Sections 363, 366, 368, 376-D, 384, 313, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 66-A, 66-E of Information Technology Act, registered at Police Station Kanwan, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, have joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Hemraj, submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitions are allowed and orders granting interim bail to the petitioners are made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
