Petitioner-Karamjit Kaur has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.25 dated 12.04.2017, registered at Police Station Kot Dharmu, District Mansa, under Sections 409, 466, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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As per the prosecution version, present petitioner is the Sarpanch of village. Three acres land of gram panchayat has been given to a brick-kiln for digging without taking proper sanction from the competent authority. In two acres of land, six pits of four feet each were dug. The amount of lease money has not been deposited in the account.

At the time of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has denied the whole prosecution version.

However, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
