The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.48 dated 23.02.2017 registered under Sections 307, 34 and 120 B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sector-34, Chandigarh.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 03.03.2017 and all the co-accused of the petitioner have already been granted regular bail by this Court and reference is made to Annexure P-3 to Annexure P-7 including the Himanshu @ Gujjar who is the main accused.

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned counsel for U.T. Chandigarh on instructions from Sub Inspector Vikram Singh.

In view of the fact that there are 22 prosecution witnesses and out of them only 19 witnesses have been examined till date, but in view of the fact that all the co-accused of the petitioner have

already been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court, hence, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars any more. Therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is accepted. Petitioner-Usha be admitted to bail on her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
