ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 207 dated 02.07.2018, registered under Sections 365, 370, 201 and 120-B IPC and Section 4 of the POCSO Act, Police Station City Mahesh Nagar, District Ambala.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the daughter of the complainant and one more girl aged 12 & 14 years were missing since 01.07.2018 and they were recovered 4 days later and the allegations against the petitioner are that he was driving the car in which the girls were transported. Counsel further submits that in the statement given by the girls they were taken from Ambala to Ludhiana in the train.

The victims had made a statement that they were lured with a

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job and were taken by Mahi Bhatia. The allegations are that the co-accused were involved in sale of child victims. The petitioner was not named by the victims.

Investigation is over. The trial would take time. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
