Petitioners-Mamta Rani and Ravi Shastri have averred that they have married against wishes of respondents No.4 and 5, who are parents of petitioner No.2. Petitioner No.1 has annexed copy of his Aadhar Card to the effect that he is aged 32 years and petitioner No.2 has annexed copy of Middle Standard Examination indicating her age as 31 years.

The petitioners apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 & 5 and thus seek issuance of appropriate directions.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar to look into the representation (Annexure P-4) made by petitioners, in accordance with law, immediately upon receipt of certified copy of this order. In case any serious apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners is found, requisite steps be taken immediately, in accordance with law, to protect life and liberty of the petitioners.

However, the aforesaid order shall not be taken to be any expression regarding validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.
