FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

This is second anticipatory bail application filed by the accused petitioners Sonia Kumari and her husband Suresh Kumar under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0098 dated 02.06.2018 under Sections 304-B and 34 IPC pertaining to Police Station Moti Nagar, Ludhiana, the first one having been dismissed by this Court vide orders dated 26.10.2018 passed in CRM-M No.30091 of 2018 (Annexure P6).

This Court while passing a detailed order on 26.10.2018 on the first bail application, has considered at length the stands of the two sides and what is sought to be argued that the petitioners were separate from the deceased and her husband, was well considered in the previous orders dated 26.10.2018. No fresh ground could be canvassed or highlighted in her submissions by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Since a detailed order has already been passed declining the anticipatory bail pleas of both these accused petitioners, no fresh ground could be brought to the notice of this Court nor appears to have been made out. Thus, no ground to show further interference is made out. The petition stands dismissed accordingly.
