Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that though appeal against conviction is pending before the Appellate Court, and appellant was granted 30 days time for depositing of 25% of the compensation amount. It is contended that Section 148 of the Negotiable Instruments (Amendment) Act, 2018 (hereinafter referred as 'the Act'), provides a period of 90 days.

The issue raised in this petition regarding applicability of Section 148 of the Act and the period, need not to be gone into at this stage. However, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the petition by extending the period upto 25th December, 2018, for depositing the requisite

amount.

It is made clear that no further extension shall be granted.
