ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 76 dated 04.07.2017, registered under Sections 306 (Section 304-B IPC added later on), Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

The counsel for the petitioner contends that an alternative charge under Section 302 IPC was also added and inadvertently they have not mentioned the same in the title/prayer and they may be allowed to amend the same.

The oral request made by the petitioner is allowed. Reader to make the entry in the title of the petition.

The petitioner is the sister-in-law of the deceased. She is in custody since 04.07.2017. The husband of the deceased was also arrested. There are some accused who are yet to be arrested. The challan has been presented as against the petitioner and charge has been framed. The

deceased had consumed poison. The petitioner, her daughter and nine months old daughter of the deceased are lodged in the jail. The role attributed in the FIR against the in-laws is that they did not allow the deceased to speak to her family.

The trial will take time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
