This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.122 dated 02.09.2014, registered at Police Station Bhogpur, Jalandhar, under Sections 420, 380, 448 and 506 IPC and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 10.11.2017, report dated 13.12.2017, has been received from Ms. Harpreet Kaur, Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 accepts the factum of compromise (Annexure P-3) and states that the

compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.122 dated 02.09.2014, registered at Police Station Bhogpur, Jalandhar, under Sections 420, 380, 448 and 506 IPC alongwith all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, is quashed.
