Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to get the investigation in FIR No. 1336 dated 03.11.2017, under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the IPC and Section 3/33/89 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (*for short 'SC/ST Act'*), registered at Police Station Ballabhgarh City, District Faridabad conducted through Crime Branch or by any senior police officer.

Reply by way of affidavit of the Assistant Commissioner of Police, City Ballabhgarh, Faridabad has been filed and as per this affidavit, after registration of the case, the investigation was entrusted to one ASI Prem Dutt, Police Post Adarsh Nagar and during investigation, Section 3 of the SC/ST Act was added and thereafter, DCP, Ballabhgarh entrusted the investigation to ACP, Ballabhgarh who verified the facts and found that the full and final payment has been made but no sale deed has been executed. Thereafter, Section 3 of the SC/ST Act was deleted and one person, namely

Sunil, was found to be innocent. It is further stated that as per the investigation, arrest warrants against accused Narender have been issued by the Illaqa Magistrate and further action will be taken after the arrest of the said person.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the Illaqa Magistrate where the further proceedings are pending for effecting arrest of accused Narender.
