Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.51 dated 17.03.2018 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Shahkot, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that 110 gms. of intoxicating powder containing 'Alprazolam' salt was recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

Learned State Counsel has produced the custody certificate of the petitioner. As per custody certificate, FIR Nos.162/2017 and 353/2017 under Section 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala, are already registered against the petitioner.

In view of the above, no ground to grant regular bail is made

Dismissed.

However, in case, learned counsel for the petitioner finds that the information supplied by learned State Counsel is incorrect, he is at liberty to seek revival of the present petition.
