ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.89 dated 29.07.2016 under Sections 452/323/324/336/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is an outcome of a sudden quarrel between the residents of same village. He further contends that although Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act have been mentioned in the FIR, but no fire arm injury was caused to anyone. The matter has now been compromised.

A co-ordinate Bench of this Court by the order dated 10.01.2018 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa

Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Bathinda, has sent a report dated 25.01.2018 (filed in connected case bearing CRM No. M-547 of 2018) wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

The FIR is an outcome of a sudden quarrel between the residents of same village which has now been resolved.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" **2014 (6) SCC 466**, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 654 dated 18.12.2013 under Sections 341/452/323/506/34 IPC registered at Police Station Ratia, District Fatehabad and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
