Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.52 dated 23.08.2017, registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 13(1) (d) and 13(1) (2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, a fraud has been committed by taking loan limit from the bank etc. on the basis of some forged

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mortgage deed, which was obtained through impersonation. As per the allegation, the present petitioner, who was posted as *Patwari* had not made any entry in the *roznamcha* qua the same and if that entry would have been there, then the fraud could be avoided.

The petitioner has been in custody since 10.10.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
