This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 259 dated 21.09.2017, under Sections 306 and 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda.

Even though, by order dated 04.04.2018, the petitioner had been granted regular bail, however, on that date, counsel for the complainant had submitted that they were having the custody of the minor child borne to the petitioner and the deceased. Counsel for the petitioner had submitted that petitioner would like to take the custody of the minor child. The case was adjourned for today.

The case has been taken up for hearing today. The petitioner is present in Court who submits that he would like to take the custody of the minor child. However, counsel for the complainant has raised objection to

the submission of the petitioner by submitting that the complainant is caring for the welfare of the minor child and she would like to continue with the custody of the minor child.

I have heard counsel for the parties. The petitioner has already been granted regular bail. Since the issue of custody of the minor child is not before this Court, no further orders are called for in this matter and the same is disposed of accordingly.
