ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN,J. (Oral):

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 1 and 2 to take action against respondent No.3 for registration of FIR, in view of the allegations in FIR No. 105 dated 21.10.2017, under Sections 420/406/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kot Dharmu, District Mansa.

Reply by way of affidavit of DSP, Sub-Division, Sardulgarh, District Mansa, on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. In reply, it is stated that the petitioner himself is an accused in FIR No. 105 dated 21.10.2017 and he is absconding from the Court proceedings. It is further stated in the reply that one co-accused, namely, Buta Singh was arrested on 27.12.2017 and challan against him has already been presented.

Since, the petitioner himself is an accused in aforesaid FIR, instead of filing an application for anticipatory bail or surrendering before the trial Court, he has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with aforesaid prayer, therefore, no further action is required in this petition and the same is rendered as infructuous.
