Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.265 dated 19.10.2018 under Sections 307/506/148/149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised with the complainant and petitioner will file a petition praying for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel appearing for complainant-Gurjit Singh has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

Learned State counsel, on instruction from ASI Ajaib Singh, submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner took out a weapon and threatened the complainant to kill him and fired a shot but the complainant saved himself.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting anything upon the merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 19.10.2018 and in view of the fact that the matter has been compromised, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail, in FIR No. 265 dated 19.10.2018 under Sections 307/506/148/149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
